Denton County health officials announced Friday that a sixth person has died from COVID-19 coronavirus.

The latest death was a woman in her 70s who lived at a nursing facility in Lewisville. Nineteen new cases of COVID-19 were also reported on Friday, bringing the total number of cases in Denton County to 273.

- In Texas: 6,556 cases and 116 deaths have been reported across the state as of April 4, 2020.
- In North Texas: Cases in Dallas County, 1,105; Tarrant, 404; Collin, 256; Denton County, 273. There have been at least 36 deaths total in those counties.

Dallas County on Sunday reported 97 new confirmed cases of the new coronavirus.

The county has reported a total of 1,112 cases and 18 deaths. There have been more than 2,200 cases of COVID-19 confirmed in North Texas.

Of the cases that have required hospitalization, 71% have been patients over 60 or people who have had at least one known high-risk chronic health condition, according to the county.

On Sunday, Cuomo said 594 more New York deaths had occurred, a total which actually represented a decline from Saturday's toll of 630 fatalities, the worst day yet. New hospitalizations also dropped by half to 574, compared to 1,095 on Saturday. That's also down from the 1,427 recorded on Friday.

Approximately 4,159 New Yorkers have now died from the pandemic out of 122,031 confirmed cases, Cuomo said. "The [coronavirus](#) is truly vicious and effective," he said. "It's an effective killer."

The dip below 600 new hospitalizations is the first time since March 22 that's been achieved.

Italy Dropping in Death Toll

Italy reported its lowest daily COVID-19 death toll for more than two weeks on Sunday as authorities began to look ahead to a second phase of the battle against the new coronavirus once the lockdown imposed almost a month ago is eventually eased.

The toll from the world's deadliest outbreak reached 15,887, almost a quarter of the global death total, but the rise of 525 from a day earlier was the smallest daily increase since March 19, while the [number of patients](#) in badly stretched intensive care units fell for a second day running.
