# WHAT ABOUT MY KIDS?

*We care deeply that your family is able to worship Jesus together in a meaningful way. Currently C3Kids ministry is online only, but we encourage you to bring your children to our Sunday service. Please follow these guidelines to help us worship as a body.*

## *Worship Together as a Family*

Worshipping as a family, although it requires more effort, can have great benefits. **Even from an early age, your children will learn to recognize the grace of God as the corporate body worships together.** Your children are shaped when you model praying, singing, listening, reading, and more while worshipping together.

## *We Are Okay With Extra Noise*

Children are a blessing, not a burden. We know babies make lots of noise, and kids can have trouble sitting still. **God may be using this time to help us learn to love the blessing of our children as a means of worshipping Him, not a distraction.** So don't feel bad if your kiddos aren't perfectly quiet. Ask an usher for some resources like kids notes that may help older children stay engaged.

## *If Things Get Too Unruly...*

Try as we may, **meltdowns do happen. We get it, don't feel bad!** If you need a place to get away with your child or children at any point during the service, simply get up and ask an usher to direct you to one of our **private Family Rooms**. These are private areas where your children can color & play and you can live-stream the service. If you need to get up just for a second to calm your child, but would like to stay in the sanctuary, there is space in the back where you can stand and still participate in the service.
