Because the Gospel renews our relationships, we commit to being a church that sees one another in light of God's grace. We will love one another as God has loved us, bearing one another's burdens, forgiving one another, admonishing one another with gentleness, watching over one another, and working and praying for the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. We will not forsake the regular meeting together as a church body, nor neglect to pray for ourselves and others.

Because the Gospel renews our hands and feet, we commit to being a church that loves one another and our neighbors through service. We will work together to see a faithful gospel ministry continued in this church through the giving of our time, talents, and treasure. We will contribute cheerfully and regularly to the support of the ministry, the expenses of the church, the relief of the poor, and the spread of the Gospel to all nations.

Because the Gospel renews our priorities, we commit to being a church that is unified around the purposes of God to save sinners. We will work to raise up our children, or anyone who is at any time under our care, in the hope of the Gospel, and by a pure and loving example prayerfully seek the salvation of our family and friends.
